Investigating Materials: Explore and investigate different, everyday materials using their senses both indoor and outdoor.

Art

Laurence Lowry will be one of the artists year 1 will study this term. His art is best known for showing urban landscapes with human figures often referred to as 'matchstick men'. The children will be working towards creating their own paintings in the style of Lowry using a restricted palette of 5 colours.







Geography

- The world: exploring maps of the world in their different forms (maps, globes, atlas) and use compass points to help read them.
- The UK: exploring the four nations of the United Kingdom in more detail and learn about their location and human and physical features.

DT

- Solid structures: Building fluency ir using our hands and fingers to create our own structures that are stable.
- Sliders, rods and objects: learning to attach an object to a slider rod in various ways so that it stands out from the background.

Music

This term, children will experience and explore hearing and making long and short sounds on a variety of instruments. They will use their listening skills to identify the different sounds and follow and create signals when performing. The children learn a simple rhyme to establish the concept of syllables and rhythms and will explore how the pulse is integral to keeping in time when performing music.

History

PSHE

With their class teachers they will be developing their coordination through footwork, their balance and agility through jumping and landing and balancing on one leg with a varying levels of challenge.
